DIRECTIONS:

From I-880, at Fremont Blvd. exit and turn right. Make the first left at Industrial Way, then first left onto Industrial Place. Proceed to the end of the court. NOTE: There are two Fremont Blvd. exits from I-880. Take the exit between Auto Mall Pkwy and Warren Ave. / Mission Blvd.

From I-680, take Auto Mall Pkwy exit, turn left at the light. Make a left at Fremont Blvd. (second light) and right at Industrial Way (across from the Nummi Auto plant). Make first left onto Industrial Place. Proceed to the end of the court.

Beginning rally is a fun and positive way to teach on-leash obedience. You can talk, clap or pat your leg to help your dog learn each routine. Training treats OK, too.
