WHERE: The Baylands Nature Preserve, Palo Alto. **NEW LOCATION!**

DIRECTIONS: From Hwy. 101, take the San Antonio Road (Mountain View) exit east toward the Bay. Continue east on San Antonio Road until it comes to an end at Terminal Blvd., right turn only. You will see the park entrance and plenty of parking spaces along Terminal. Parking is free. This is our staging area. Look for Airedales! Cell contact: Sarah Roberts, 510-791-7886.

There will be both long (4 mi.) and short walk options (turn back any time) on a broad gravel path that winds along on levees in the Bay sloughs. The Baylands preserve includes some of the last remaining salt marsh/mudflat habitats on the West Coast and provides excellent bird-watching opportunities. Leashes are required, no flexi-leads, please. Bring water for your dog and poop bags. Bring a jacket or windbreaker. Chilly winds are common, even though the rest of the Peninsula may be warm!

BYOBB: Bring your own brown bag lunch. When we get tired of walking, those who would like are invited to caravan with us for a short distance along East Bayshore Road. Turning right on Embarcadero Road, we will re-enter the park and enjoy our lunch in the charming picnic area by the ranger station.
