California State University East Bay (CSUEB) is a public university located in Hayward, CA.

The university is part of the 23-campus California State University system.

CSUEB has three campuses: Hayward, Concord, and Oakland.

CSUEB was first established in 1957 as State College for Alameda County.

The initial 2,500 student population has increased to over 14,000.

Cal State East Bay is consistently named as one of the most diverse public institutions in the continental U.S.

In 2005, in an attempt to broaden its service to the East Bay, Cal State University Hayward changed its name to CSUEB.

Groundbreaking on the current Hayward campus began in 1961 on the Timm Hauschildt cattle ranch.

The campus has grown immensely since CATC's past walk in March, 2017.

The school's mascot is Pioneer Pete!

Due to seismic concerns, Warren Hall was imploded on August 17, 2013 at 11:29. The explosion was heard by attendees at CATC's Fun Day in Newark!
